

PyCharm Shortcuts

Ctrl + C: Copy selected text.

Ctrl + V: Paste selected text.

Ctrl + X: Cut selected text.

Ctrl + Z: Undo the last action.

Ctrl + Shift + Z: Redo the last action.

Ctrl + F: Search for a word or phrase in the current file.

Ctrl + R: Replace a word or phrase in the current file.

Ctrl + Shift + F: Search for a word or phrase in the entire project.

Ctrl + Shift + R: Replace a word or phrase in the entire project.

Ctrl + S: Save changes to the current file.

Ctrl + N: Create a new file.

Ctrl + O: Open an existing file.

Ctrl + Shift + N: Create a new folder.

Ctrl + Shift + O: Open an existing folder.

Ctrl + Alt + L: Reformat code to conform to the project's code style.

Ctrl + Space: Show suggestions for completing the current statement.

Ctrl + /: Comment or uncomment a line or block of code.

Ctrl + Shift + C: Copy the full path of the current file to the clipboard.

Ctrl + Alt + T: Surround selected text with a code construct, such as if, for, or try-catch.

Ctrl + Shift + F10: Run the current configuration, such as a Python script or a test suite.

Alt + Enter: Show the available intentions for the current context, such as import statements, missing variables, and typos.

Ctrl + B: Jump to the definition of the symbol under the cursor.

Ctrl + G: Go to line number.

Ctrl + W: Expand the current selection.

Ctrl + Shift + W: Shrink the current selection.

Ctrl + Alt + S: Open the PyCharm settings.

Ctrl + Alt + Left/Right Arrow: Navigate to the previous/next cursor position.

Ctrl + Shift + T: Generate a new test file for the current file.

Ctrl + Alt + V: Extract a variable.

Ctrl + Alt + M: Extract a method.

Ctrl + Alt + C: Extract a constant.

Ctrl + Alt + P: Extract a parameter.

Ctrl + Shift + I: Show the definition of a symbol in a tooltip.

Ctrl + Shift + U: Toggle the case of the selected text.

Ctrl + Shift + L: Show the available refactoring options, such as renaming, extracting, and inlining.

Ctrl + Shift + Alt + T: Show the available templates for creating new files, such as classes, modules, and scripts.

Ctrl + Shift + F7: Highlight all occurrences of the symbol under the cursor.

Ctrl + Shift + Alt + S: Open the project structure.

Ctrl + Alt + B: Jump to the implementation of the symbol under the cursor.

Ctrl + Shift + F12: Toggle full screen mode.

Ctrl + Tab: Switch to the next tab.

Ctrl + Shift + Tab: Switch to the previous tab.

Alt + F1: Show the currently selected file or symbol in the project explorer.

Alt + F7: Find usages of the symbol under the cursor.

Ctrl + Alt + F7: Show usages of the symbol under the cursor in a dialog.

Ctrl + Shift + Alt + F7: Show usages of the symbol under the cursor in the editor.
